### The "Perfect Pitch"

On September 9, Mattie Miracle took the plunge on a live Zoom event, hosted by Shark Tank's own Daymond John. Mattie Miracle gave a four minute pitch, followed by four minutes of questions. In Daymond John's own words, "Mattie Miracle delivered the perfect pitch!"

We are grateful that **200** supporters registered, watched and voted for us. Thanks to your efforts, Mattie Miracle was awarded \$7,500 by Thrivent. Our message deeply resonated with the childhood cancer community as well, and thanks to the generosity of a family affected by childhood cancer, Mattie Miracle received, **\$10,000**, in total that night, to start a new psychosocial initiative.

We received many beautiful chat messages during the Zoom event. Here are a few:

- Go Vicki! Your partnership with patients, families, and our psychosocial teams across the country in children's hospitals is invaluable! Vote for the Mattie Miracle Cancer Foundation!
- I love this mission! We need to understand the emotional fallout of a cancer diagnosis, especially in children who need resources to understand what is happening to them.
- Our son was diagnosed with a childhood brain tumor at the age of 13.
   While undergoing chemo, radiation, surgery, and two bone marrow transplants at two major medical centers, our son was never once offered psychosocial evaluation or counseling either during treatment or afterwards. Mattie Miracle is doing amazing and critical work to highlight

- the need for psychosocial support for kids diagnosed with cancer, their siblings, and parents.
- Go Mattie Miracle! My son is a childhood cancer survivor. There are not
  just the days, months, and years of cancer treatment that we need to
  cope with and survive. But all the psychosocial, mental health issues, and
  PTSD that we contend with years after the treatment is over. This needs
  to be addressed. I know my son has some of these issues, which aren't
  covered by healthcare insurance. Please pick Mattie Miracle for 1st place
  as this is such a needed service.
- Absolutely essential service and hugely needed with love and appreciation from a long-time childhood cancer nurse.
- Mattie Miracle is a phenomenal Foundation that spends countless hours and non-profit resources to provide essential psychosocial support to pediatric cancer patients and their families. I am a nurse who is very familiar with the Foundation, and I have seen the amazing ways, in my own job, that their Foundation has made an extraordinary impact.
