
It was a very moving experience for Mattie Miracle to attend Kearney & Company's virtual event. We received many heartfelt chat messages that evening from participants, such as:

755 Patient Interventions

Mattie Miracle is proud to fund a **full-time child life professional**, Adina Levitan, at Children's Hospital at Sinai in Baltimore, MD. Adina understands that childhood cancer IS NOT JUST ABOUT THE MEDICINE, and she represents the Foundation's mission beautifully.

Certified Child Life Specialists generate positive behavioral, psychological, and physiological outcomes through individualized interventions with pediatric patients. They implement an array of play-based, coping-focused techniques shown to ameliorate pain, lower anxiety, reduce distress, and increase satisfaction with institutions of care. Children demonstrate fewer behavioral disturbances during and beyond medical encounters when receiving comprehensive preparation, procedural support, and coping skills education, all of which are associated with accelerated healing.

In the six month time period between July to December 2020, we are proud to report that Adina directly assisted children and their families by performing **755 patient interventions**. The interventions fall within 12 categories, and the percentages indicate the number of children receiving each intervention:

- 1. Normalization/Play 22%
- 2. Emotional Support 19%
- 3. Introduction to Services 18%
- 4. Parent Support 15%
- 5. Procedural Support 7%
- 6. Procedural Distraction 6%
- 7. Psychological Preparation 6%
- 8. Therapeutic Play 3%
- 9. Diagnosis Education 1%
- 10. Sibling Support 1%
- 11. Memory Making/Legacy 1%
- 12. Bereavement/End of Life 1%

575 Families Supported

Mattie Miracle launched its Snack & Item Cart at Children's Hospital at Sinai in Baltimore, MD in March of 2017. The Cart offers free snacks, drinks, and toiletry items to all inpatient families caring for children with cancer and other life-threatening illnesses. It Is difficult for parents and caregivers to leave their child's bedside to get their basic needs met, therefore the Cart provides this important psychosocial service. On average, Mattie Miracle donates over \$10,000 worth of items to our Carts per year and the Carts are supported by 110 individual donors, 35 schools, and 40 businesses and organizations.

From July to December 2020, the Mattie Miracle Snack & Item Cart provided:

1) 846 snacks, 2) 11,343 pieces of candy, and 3) 373 toiletry items to 575 pediatric families at Children's Hospital at Sinai.

Our **Toiletry Drive** is an annual event that we host in memory of Mattie Brown's April birthday. The Drive helps to stock our Snack and Item carts at MedStar Georgetown University Hospital (Washington, DC) and Children's Hospital at Sinai (Baltimore, MD).

Our Carts provide free candy, nutritious snacks, drinks, and toiletries to families caring for children with cancer or other life-threatening illnesses. Annually we:

- serve 2,500 families
- distribute over 55,000 pieces of candy
- provide 1,500 toiletries
