# 2021 Highlights

As 2021 draws to a close, we reflect on this year's highlights and accomplishments. Together, with your support, we have made many Mattie Miracles possible.

- Endowed the Mattie Miracle Child Life Program Fund, by donating \$53,000 to support a full-time <u>child life specialist</u> position.
- 2. Funded Psychosocial Standards of Care implementation <u>research grants</u>, totaling \$100,000 across 17 studies.
- 3. Operated the Mattie Miracle Free Snack & Item Carts for in-patient pediatric families at the MedStar Georgetown University Hospital (Washington, DC) and at Children's Hospital at Sinai (Baltimore, MD). These carts serviced over 2,500 families this year.
- 4. Launched a new Snack and Item Cart at the National Institutes of Health's Clinical Center (Rockville, MD).
- Held the virtual <u>12th Walk & Family</u> <u>Festival</u>, generating \$125,000 and with walkers from all 50 states and six countries.
- Coordinated two annual community item drives (candy and toiletries) to help stock our hospital Snack & Item carts.
- 7. Secured international <u>endorsement</u> of the Psychosocial Standards of Care.
- 8. Interviewed for the Help and Hope Happen Here <u>Podcast</u>.
- Created the <u>M&M Wishes Program</u> in memory of our board member, Margy Jost. This program will provide family grants up to \$1,000 to support a fun family activity, trip, or a wish list item for a child with cancer.
- Competed on Shark Tank and Daymond John's said Mattie Miracle delivered the "perfect pitch." We were

awarded \$10,000 to start a new psychosocial initiative.
