Over the last 11 years, together we have:

- 1. Raised \$810,000 to fund our psychosocial programs
- 2. Supported 35,000 children with cancer
- 3. Funded 4 child life specialists
- 4. Awarded \$67,000 in psychosocial research grants
- 5. Published the first evidence based <u>Psychosocial Standards of</u> <u>Care</u>
- 6. Sponsored the publication of the <u>Matrix and Guidelines</u> to help implement the Psychosocial Standards of Care
- 7. Offered 26,000 snacks to in-patient families
- 8. Donated 59,000 pounds of candy and 25,000 toiletry items to families
- 9. Introduced House Resolution 262
- 10. Added Psychosocial Language to the <u>STAR Act</u> (signed into law June 2018)

2020 Highlights

As 2020 draws to a close, we reflect on this year's highlights and accomplishments. Together, with your support, we have made many Mattie Miracles possible.

- 1. Established a <u>\$10,000 Coronavirus Family Relief Grant Program</u> and donated \$2,000 in technology items to help bridge the communications gap between patients and families.
- 2. Funded the publication of the Psychosocial Standards of Care <u>Matrix and Guidelines</u>, a toolkit to implement the Standards at treatment sites around the country.
- Testified before the <u>Committee on Childhood Cancers and Disability</u> (part of the National Academies of Sciences) in Washington, DC. Highlighted the physical and psychological impairments that arise from treatment.
- 4. Funded Psychosocial Standards of Care implementation <u>research grants</u>, totaling \$67,000 across 12 studies.
- 5. Endowed the Mattie Miracle Child Life Program Fund, by donating \$46,000 to support a <u>full-time child life specialist position</u>.
- 6. Operated the Mattie Miracle Free Snack & Item Carts for in-patient pediatric families at the MedStar Georgetown University Hospital (Washington, DC) and at Children's Hospital at Sinai (Baltimore, MD). The carts serviced over 1,500 families this year.
- 7. Held the virtual <u>11th Walk & Family Festival</u>, generating \$110,000 and with walkers from all 50 states and eight countries.
- 8. Coordinated two annual <u>community item drives</u> (candy and toiletries) to help stock our hospital Snack & Item carts.
- 9. Interviewed for the <u>Promise Docuseries on Childhood Cancer</u>, a production funded by the non-cancer community.
- 10. Hosted a virtual Psychosocial Standards of Care Research Symposium at the 17th annual <u>American Psychosocial Oncology Society (APOS) Conference</u>.
